Known Issues & Recommendations in ArtPro+ 16.0

Feature	Release Note
Transform tool	Moving, scaling or rotating an object interactively is less smooth on Mac OS 10.11 (El Capitan)
Expand button	Some high-level objects can be expanded (degraded). After Undo of the Expand, the object remains degraded. For barcodes, Expanding is temporarily disabled.
Browse	If you have an Automation Engine connection, the browse dialogs come with a Search button and Open Recent Places dropdown. Sometimes these may not seem responsive. In that case, resizing the dialog should help.
AE connection	If you have an Automation Engine connection set up on Mac OS 10.11 (El Capitan), be sure to show the "Options" in the Open dialog. Otherwise you will not see the Automation Engine search options.
Marks	When creating marks, be sure to use all required separations in an actual object in the document; not just in the mark itself. This will avoid any issues with empty marks (referring to dynamic colors that are not used).
Marks	It is not recommended to apply marks to PDF documents that are larger than 200 by 200 inches (= approximately 5 by 5 metres) in this version yet.
