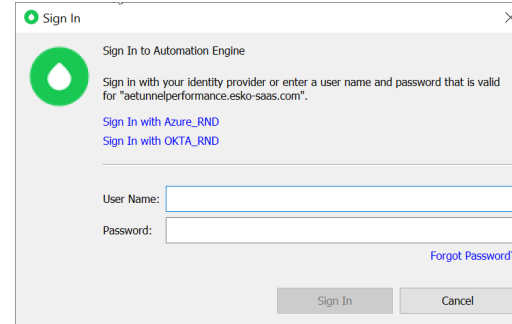
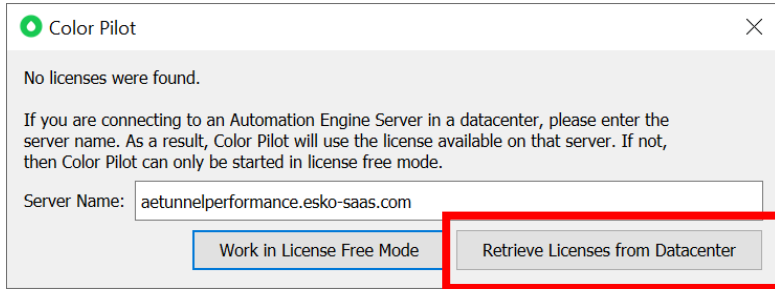
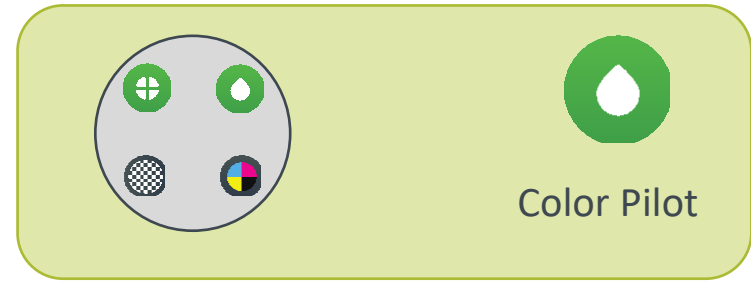
# License check 22.11



- Licenses will be stored on AE SaaS
- On start up the local Color Pilot will check & validate the AE SaaS
- Color Pilot will run in license free mode if no licenses are found
- Screens, Curves, Inkbooks stored?



# License check 22.11



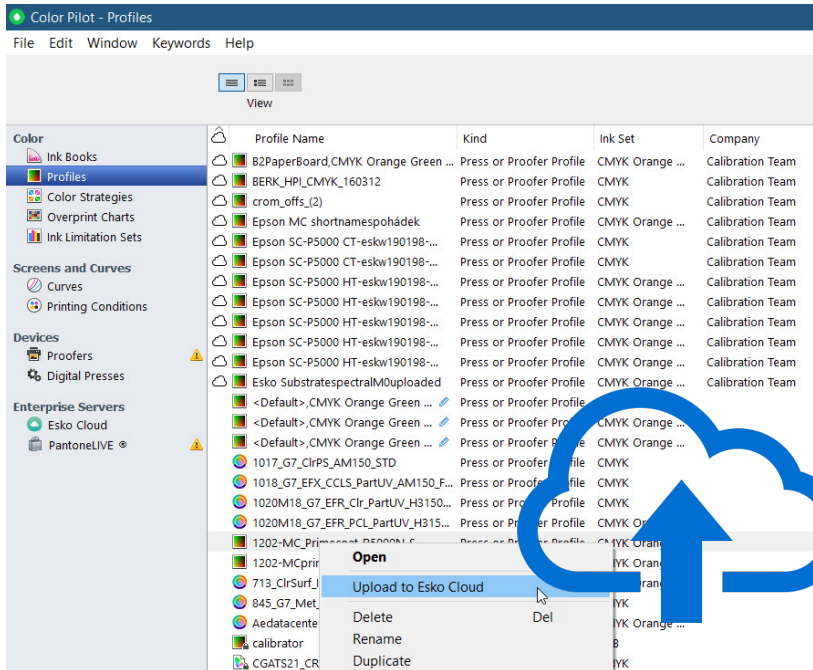
- Licenses will be stored on AE SaaS
- No license found > license free mode or licenses are retrieved from AE SaaS
- Once connected AE SaaS details are automatically completed in Color Pilot Preferences

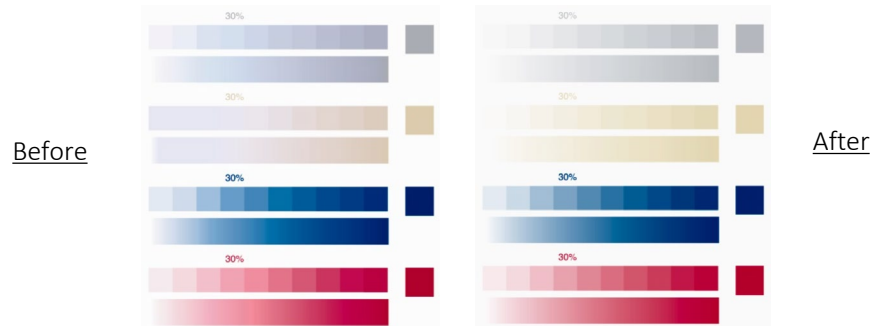
# Color Pilot 22.11 – Hotfixes

- Hotfix 1: Automation Engine & Color Pilot

- Automation Engine: Proof server Workflow names with non – English characters may not show correctly in the task panel of the ‘Proof for Contract/Content Approval’ tasks
- Color Pilot: When printing the proof charts you see a ‘Successfully sent to the proof server’ message. However, they don’t arrive in the Command Workstation because the chart name contains non – English characters

- Hotfix 2: Imaging Engine

- Imaging Engine: Tints of Unprofiled inks are being output too blueish, when the "Tint Behavior for unprofiled Inks" is set to "Interpolate Solid Conversion".
